<Import AVCHD>

② Select [PRIVATE¥AVCHD] folder of a SD card on Media Browser to display thumbnails.

<Import MOV>

③ Select [PRIVATE¥PANA_GRP¥subfolder(e.g. 001RFQAM)] of a SD card on Media Browser to display thumbnails.

<Import MP4>

③ Select [PRIVATE¥PANA_GRP¥subfolder(e.g. 003RCPAM)] of a SD card on Media Browser to display thumbnails.

④ Select clips, import them into a bin of a project by drag and drop.
